It was believed during Roman times that a marriage during June would ensure a happy household and family. This is a nice sentiment; however, it is based on faith in an idol granting one their heart's desire. Any source put before God is an idol. Regardless of our best wishes and intentions, idols have no power to grant our desires. It is not surprising then, that these are so often not fulfilled. The Word of God has much to say about Brides, Bridegrooms, and marriage. I'd like to share this word of prophecy from the Book of Isaiah 62:4, "Never again will you be called 'The Forsaken City' or 'The Desolate Land.' Knowing a Bird by Its Song

Birding—or the hobby of observing birds in the wild—is often more about listening than seeing. This is because birds are often hidden in a canopy of leaves, forcing would-be bird watchers to rely on their ears to locate and identify the species around them.

To learn to recognize a bird by sound alone, birders will often associate phrases with certain calls. For example, many associate the phrase "Who cooks for you?" with the sounds made by a barred owl. This trick is a good way to learn some of the more common bird songs.

In addition, organizations such as the Cornell Lab of Ornithology maintain an online collection of recordings that allow birders to practice identifying songs in a controlled setting—and, of course, there are now apps that can be used to identify bird songs in the field.

Being able to recognize a bird song comes from repeated exposures to the myriad of chirps, tweets, and screeches that birds can emit. It takes attention, concentration, and a willingness to learn from an expert to become a true birder.

And being a Christian can sometimes feel like being a bird watcher: The focus of our attention (God) isn't something we're likely to see, but we can come to recognize His voice, with practice and mindfulness.

That is not to say that God will speak to us from a burning bush or on top of a mountain, as he did with Moses. He does, however, communicate with us—and we need to be able to sort out His voice from the cacophony of messages we're bombarded with, each one professing to bring us closer to happiness or to the right choice.

Learning to recognize God's voice comes from repeated exposure and training. That is, it comes from knowing the Bible and from learning from good, reliable teachers how to interpret what we read and what we experience as we walk with God and encounter the Holy Spirit.

Like birding, learning to truly hear God takes time and attention. It is not a casual pursuit that one can just pick up in a day. It is a lifetime of study and listening.
